
Infant's Death

Dr John P O'Leary, Coroner for East Limerick, and a jury, opened an inquest at the County Hospital, Croom, on Annie O'Connor, an infant, aged four months, of Clappa, Foynes, Co Limerick, who died at Croom Hospital on the 24th February. Dr T J McMahon, House Surgeon, Croom, stated that in his opinion the child died from myocardiac degeneration. If the child were a normal one it should have responded to treatment and improved while in the hospital.

Supt Cooney remarked that the child had been boarded out prior to admission to the hospital. He then applied for an adjournment of the inquest "sine die" as he desired to report to his authorities.
