

Death of Mr Manning Robertson

The death occurred at his home, 10 Ragan Road, Dublin, on Saturday, March 17, of Manning Robertson, F.R.I.B.A., the well known architect and town planning authority. Mr Manning Robertson was educated at Eton and Oxford and was articled to the late Sir Ernest George R.A., and was Deputy Chief Architect to the Housing Department of the British Ministry of Health for many years. In 1925 he came to Ireland and established a practice here as an architect and Town Planning Consultant. He was Town Planning Consultant for Cork, Limerick, Dun Laoghaire, and collaborated with Sir Patrick Abercrombie and Sedney Kelly on the Dublin sketch plan. He was first chairman of the Irish branch of the Town Planning Institute. He also made the speeches recently in connection with proposed street improvements in Cork city.
