## Co. Old I.R.A. Man Dies in U.S.A.

A man prominent in the Irish War of Independence has died in St Louis, Missouri, U S.A., in the person of Mr Michael Coleman, a native of Bruree, Co. Limerick, A member of a family with atrong national inclinations, the late Mr Coleman was a Lieutenant in the Brures Company of the Old I R.A. Joining the Volunteers at the outset, he took part in the Bruree ambush, was prominent in the successful Kilmaliock Barrack attack, saw service in the Grange ambush and many other en gagenicuts. He was toterned for a year and a half in the Curragh, and emigrated 1 to America in 1926. He was brother of Garda l'atrick Co eman, who is stationed in Clonbullogue, Kildare, of Mr James Coleman, also in St Louis, and of Mrs P Potter, Howardstown, Bruree.
