

## Co. Old I.R.A. Man Dies in U.S.A.

A man prominent in the Irish War of Independence has died in St Louis, Missouri, U.S.A., in the person of Mr Michael Coleman, a native of Bruree, Co. Limerick. A member of a family with strong national inclinations, the late Mr Coleman was a Lieutenant in the Bruree Company of the Old I.R.A. Joining the Volunteers at the outset, he took part in the Bruree ambush, was prominent in the successful Kilmallock Barrack attack, saw service in the Grange ambush and many other engagements. He was interned for a year and a half in the Curragh, and emigrated to America in 1926. He was brother of Garda Patrick Coleman, who is stationed in Clonbullogue, Kildare, of Mr James Coleman, also in St. Louis, and of Mrs P. Potter, Howardstown, Bruree.
