## Death From Burns

### Sad Limerick Fatalities

Residents in Hogan Avenue, Kileely, on Friday afternoon, were terrified to see a little girl running down the street enveloped in flames. She was Agneta Ryan, aged 9, of 16 Hogan Avenue, who died in the City Hospital as the result of burns.

During the absence of Mrs Ryan on a shopping expedition, the deceased and her young sisters were left in the care of a neighbour, Christina Murray, aged 13. The fire needed replenishing and Christina Murray left to procure turf, and in her absence the deceased took some dry sticks from the oven and placed one piece in the fire. She then withdrew the lighting stick and it came in contact with her clothing which caught fire. Christina Murray immediately attempted to beat out the flames and remove the garment. The child, however, in a frenzy of terror, broke away and dashed into the street. Horrified observers rushed to her aid and the fire was extinguished, but not before the girl was very badly burned.
