Passing of Popular Citizen

While attending an early Mass at the Franciscan Church on Sunday morning Mr John Saunders (56), of "Fiatra," North Circular, Limerick, a commercial traveller, collapsed and expired within a few minutes. The body was subsequently removed to Barrington's Hospital. Deceased was a native of Kilrush, but had resided in Limerick for a number years, and deepest sympathy will be tendered to his wife and two children in their tragic bereavement. Death was due to natural causes and an inquest was deemed unnecessary; Deceased, who was a member of the Third Order of St Francis, had been attending the Retreat for that body during the week, and was present on Sunday morning for the General Communion.
