## ECHO OF WEST LIMERICK TRAGEDY

At the opening of the Circuit Criminal Court, at Limerick, on Tuesday, before Judge Barra O Briain, S.C.,

Mr. T. Donovan, B.L., State Counsel, said that the Attorney-General wished to enter a nolle prosequi in the case in which Thomas Condon (junior), Knockane, Newcastle West, was charged with the manslaughter of Patrick Cussen, Fanlehan, Newcastle West, by running him down with a motor lorry on the 21st October, 1945.

His Lordship granted the application.

At the last sittings of the Court, Condon was sentenced to 12 months imprisonment for the manslaughter of Richard Roche, Mahoonagh. Both men were killed in the same accident.

## UNLICENSED DOGS.

At Kilfinane Court, where there were 90 summonses against parties for having unlicensed dogs, Mr. H. L. Connor, D.J., said that where licenses had been taken out since the Guard had found the dogs he would on this occasion apply the Probation Act if there was no previous conviction, but would not do so in future. Where there were two summonses and licence was taken out before the court he would impose a fine that day of 10/- on the first and apply the Probation Act on the second.
