**DEATH OF CO. LIMERICK
 EX-SENATOR**

With much regret we announce
 the death of Mr. Michael Conway,
 Herbertstown, who passed away in
 the County Infirmary, Limerick, on
 Wednesday. The deceased was an
 ardent and life-long worker in the
 cause of labour. For many years
 he was an active member of the
 Irish Land and Labour Association
 and when that organisation ceased
 to exist he became prominently
 associated with the Cottage
 Tenants' Association. As a nominee
 of the latter body he was elected
 to Seanad Eireann, of which he
 was a member from April to Sep-
 tember, 1938. He was defeated in
 the second Seanad election of that
 year. The late Mr. Conway was a
 sincere advocate of the rights of
 the workers and did much to uplift
 that class and especially to secure
 and advance the interests of
 cottage tenants. To his bereaved
 wife and family and the other rela-
 tives we extend our sincere sym-
 pathy. The funeral took place
 to-day (Friday) from Herbertstown
 to Ballinard after Solemn Requiem
 Mass.
