

HIGH TREASON CHARGES

Both William Joyce and John Amery appear in the list for next Monday's Bailey Sessions, starting tomorrow. Joyce, who gives his occupation as 'none,' is No. 93 in the calendar, and is charged with high treason. John Amery, described as a politician, is No. 51 in the list, and is charged with treason.

AUSTRALIA'S WAR DEAD

Australian war dead from Sept. 1st, 1939, to May 31st, 1945, numbered 92,211, said Melbourne Radio last night. Of these, 36,220 died in the war against Germany. In the war against Japan, up to May 31st, there were 55,991 fatal casualties.

OLD AGE PENSIONS

Maryborough Town Commissioners have adopted a resolution from Dublin City Council, calling on the Government to introduce legislation to provide a substantial increase in old age pensions and the modification of the means test.
