
Lady's Fatal Fall

While walking on the Allbans, a 40-foot high promontory overlooking Lough Derg, near Killahee, co. Clare, Mrs Katherine McKeogh (70), a widow, slipped and fell to the roadway, sustaining a broken neck from which she died almost immediately.

The first to come on the scene was her son, who was returning home from work, and for whom the mother was on her way home to prepare his evening meal when the accident occurred.

At an inquest held, by Coroner Dr S Seanlan a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence was returned.
