
Farmer's Death

Clare Inquest Verdict

The cause of death was ruptured gastric ulcer, for a duration of two days, with cardiac failure, stated Dr Joseph Humphreys, M.O., Bridgetown, co Clare, at the inquest on Michael Moloney (58), an unmarried farmer, of Adnatagle, O'Brien's Bridge.

Deceased had been helping his brother on bog work and two days before his death complained of feeling unwell.

James Moloney, a brother, stated at the inquest conducted by Coroner Dr Scallan that he gave the deceased a half glass of castor oil mixed with milk when he complained of stomach pains; he went to fetch his sister and when he returned he found the deceased dead.

A verdict in accordance with the medical evidence was returned.
