Death of Mr Thos. Long

It is with the most sincere regret that we record the death of Mr Thomas Long, which occurred after a very brief illness at his residence, O'Connell Avenue, early on Monday, morning, the result of a heart attack. The late Mr Long was for some 54 years a member of the staff of Mesers Wm Todd & Co, where he was deservedly held in the highest esteem by everyone with whom he came in contact. He was a mest devout Catholic, and was for very many years one of the honorary secretaries of the far-famed Arch Confraternity of the Holy Family attached to the Redemptorist Church, as well as being an active member of the Limerick Conference of the St Vincent De Paul Society. Deceased was brother to the Right Rev Monsignor Long, PP, Bristol; Very Rev J J Long, PP, New Zealand, and two of his sisters are nuns, one being at sched to the Convent at Dundee, Scotland and the other in Ceylon.

The remains, followed by a huge concourse of the citizens, were removed from his late residence last night to St Michael's Church, where they at present lay pending final funeral arrangements.
