Distinguished Limerick Brother of Jesuit Order.

A distinguished and highly-revered Brother of the Jesuit Order died recently in the United States. He was Rev Brother Thomas O'Shaughnessy, S.J., a native of Ballyanna, Ahascragh, Co. Limerick, and son of the late Mr Thomas O'Shaughnessy, Ballyanna, and of Mrs Margaret O'Shaughnessy, of Joister, Loughgill. He entered the Society of Jesus on the 24th March, and celebrated his golden jubilee on the 24th of March of this year, and died on the 11th April. He was stationed at El Estero, Los Altos, at the time of his death. He was brother of the late Mrs Maurice O'Shaughnessy, Poor Rate Collector, Glin; uncle of Mrs David Leahy, Glin, and first cousin of the late Mr Patrick O'Shaughnessy, Loughill, and of the late Mr P J O'Shaughnessy, Rathkeale, and of Mr Patrick O'Shaughnessy, M.C., Ivy House, Glin.
