Found Hanged In Nenagh

"Something told me he had a rope or that he was looking for me," said Mrs Kathleen McCarthy, when she gave evidence at an inquest on her husband Patrick McCarthy (29), itinerant, a native of Taylor's Row, Limerick, who was found hanging from a tree at the Dark Road, Nenagh.

Dr James Walsh said that death was due to hanging.

The jury found deceased died from hanging, the injuries being self inflicted.

The Coroner (Dr A W Courtney), the jury and the Gardai tendered sympathy to the widow and brother.
