Sad Drowning Fatality

A Youth's Death

John Creagh, aged 13, of Back Clare street, Limerick, was drowned at Plassy, near Limerick, on Sunday evening.

The boy with his brother Stephen and and some companions were crossing the reservoir pipes over the Mulcaire river when he fell into the water.

His companions made frantic endeavours to save him and he was in their grips on saveral occasions until a strong wash forced them to let go.

Dragging operations were carried out almost immediately and were continued to Monday, but the body was not yet resovered.

The body was recovered from the river last evening, some 120 yards from where the lad became immerced.
