DONETZ ON TRIAL

THE U-BOAT CAMPAIGN

Col. Philmore, a member of the prosecuting team, began at Nuremberg to-day the case against Admiral Donetz.

It was alleged by the prosecution

that Donetz was responsible for the carrying out of the U-boat building programme after the Anglo-German naval agreement of 1935.

Official documents were quoted

to show that in four years Donetz had built up a great fleet of Uboats. In 1940, it was stated, Uboats sent to the bottom 3,000,000 tons of British shipping.
