He also had some interesting shrubs in his collection, particularly Gaultheria Hookeri, with pale blue berries, a semi-creeping lime hating, but attractive looking

There were very few entries in the commercial classes for packed fruit, and in the classes for cottiers and allotment holders. In these latter classes B. Gubbins, of South Circular Road, Limerick, and T. McNamara, Skehana Cottage, Crecora, showed remarkably high class fruit. The County Instructors might be able to induce more of these small holders to enter, and also more of the commercial growers to try their luck. Not the least important feature of the show was the number and excellence of the trade exhibits.
