TROUBLE IN U.S.A.

THOUSANDS MORE TO BE UNEMPLOYED

The 80,000 rail and steel workers already idle in the United States, because of the strike of the soft coal miners, will be added to by another 100,000 in the course of the coming week, it was feared in Washington to-day. In Pittsburgh alone 50,000 men will be affected.
