

# Fall From Horse

## American Lady's Death Near Limerick

Having been thrown from her horse while riding with a group of friends at Rockfield near Fadamore, county Limerick, Mrs Dorothy McCarthy Redfield (34), died on Friday night at the Limerick County Infirmary. She was the wife of Mr Scott F Redfield, Station Manager, American Overseas Airways at Shannon Airport.

At the time of the accident Mrs Redfield's young son was also of the party.

On Saturday, in order to permit of the remains being removed to Syracuse, New York, a post mortem examination was held at the Infirmary, from which it transpired that Mrs Redfield died from a fracture of the base of the skull and cerebral haemorrhage.

Deceased's home address is 660 University Avenue, Syracuse.

The remains have been transferred by air to New York, and an inquest will be held later.
