

Co. Boy's Sudden Death

Master M Noonan (14), only son of Mr and Mrs Noonan, Barnard, Kilmallock, took suddenly ill at his residence on Sunday evening and died shortly afterwards. He had been out hurling a short time before and had just returned to his parents' residence.

Dr J C Cgilvie, Kilmallock, and Dr M O'Connor, Kilmallock, were quickly on the scene, but life was extinct. Death was due to haemorrhage, and upon the facts being conveyed to the coroner (Dr J P Clery, Hospital) an inquest was not deemed necessary.
