## Collapses on Street

While running with a companion in the vicinity of the Sarsfield Bridge, Limerick, on Sunday night, Michael Kelly, 17, of Spallacy's Square, Wolfe Tone street, collapsed and died. He was taken to Barrington's Hospital by members of St John Ambulance Brigade, where, following a post-mortem examination, it was stated that death was due to cardiac failure.

Deceased was employed at a city grocery establishment.
