## HIT BY COAL SHORTAGE

Because available coal stocks have become exhausted the kiln department at the Cement Factory at Mungret closed down as from to-day. Upwards of about sixty hands are affected.

The manufacture of cement is still being continued, but if the kiln department remains closed for any considerable length of time there is a danger that the entire factory will become affected. In that event some 150 employees would be rendered unemployed.
