STRONG PROTEST DISTRIBUTION OF SEED OATS At a meeting of Limerick Chamber of Commerce, Mr. P. E. O'Malley, President, in the chair, strong resentment (says a supplied report) was expressed at the decision of the Department of Agriculture to appoint the County Committees of Agriculture as nominators of the merchants who would distribute imported Scotch seed oats (made available this season after a lapse of 30/12 years). The members' attention was called to the unfair method adopted whereby all the Limerick grain and seed merchants were excluded from participation in the scheme, and it was alleged that none of those who had been nominated by the Limerick County Committee of Agriculture holds a seed wheat or seed barley assemblers' permit from the Department. Owing to the serious principle involved, the matter was regarded in a grave light, and the Secretary was instructed to register to the Minister for Agriculture a strong protest against what the meeting regarded as confiscation of established traders' rights.
