### INQUEST OPENED AND ADJOURNED

At Limerick County Infirmary on Tuesday, Mr. J. F. McNeice, solr., Deputy Coroner, opened an inquest on Michael Griffin, Muingboy, Broadford, Co. Clare, who was fatally injured when he was knocked down by a lorry said to have been driven by William Carey, Limerick.
