GLIN WOMAN'S DEATH

The very unexpected death, after an hour's illness, of Mrs. John Normile, the Mall, Glin, caused a great shock to her family and Glin people generally (writes our Glin correspondent). Deceased was a hard working, industrious woman and was so engaged on Saturday, 18th inst. About an hour after she had retired, sometime about 11 p.m., she complained of a smothering, which she sometimes did get, but would be better immediately. She died within an hour of complaining. She had the spiritual attendance of Rev. Fr. Connors, C.C., and was also attended by Dr. J. Barrett, who pronounced heart failure the cause of death. Deepest sympathy is offered her bereaved family and relatives. She leaves an invalid son, whom she very carefully nursed for years. She was daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Liston, members of old Glin families. Mrs. Normile's death is the second unexpected death in Glin in a fortnight, that of Mr. James Hogan being the other. R.I.P.
