### AFTER COMING FROM THE CREAMERY

The death at an advanced age of Mr. James Normile, farmer, Turraree, Glin, took place suddenly on Monday morning (writes our Glin correspondent). He had been with his milk at the creamery and immediately complained after arriving home. The priest and doctor were sent for, but he had died before their arrival. Dr. Barrett, M.O., pronounced that death was due to natural causes. Deceased was to attend a meeting of Glin Co-operative Creamery Committee, of which he was a member. He was a member of an old Glin family reinstated during the Land League days in the 90s. Deepest sympathy is offered his family. Rev. Father Carroll, P.P., and Rev. Father Conyers, C.C., officiated at his funeral.
