LIMERICK PRIEST THE FOOD VALUE OF MILK

Dies In Australia REV. FATHER JAMES P. MADDEN, O.S.A.

Wide-spread regret has been expressed among his many friends in Ireland, particularly in the city and county of Limerick, by the death of the Rev. Father James Francis Madden, O.S.A., which occurred at St. Joseph's Priory, Cairns, Queensland, Australia, on April 5th.

The deceased was a member of a very highly respected East Limerick family being the second son of Mr. and Mrs. Edmund Madden, Caherline, Pallasgreen, and brother of the Rev. Father Edmund Madden, O.S.A., who is a chaplain in the British Army.

THE OBIQUITIES. Requiem Mass at Caherline

The remains were taken to St. Monica's Chapel, where they remained all next day, when they were transferred to the Church for the Office of the Dead. Next morning Requiem Mass was celebrated by the Rev. Father Brendan Grande, O.S.A. Rev. Father John Hanrahan, O.S.A., was deacon, and Rev. Father Ludden, O.S.A., was sub-deacon.

A large crowd of relatives and friends attended the Requiem Mass in Caherline Parish Church on April 9th. Celebrant was Rev. Father Albert Ryan, O.S.A.; deacon, Rev. Father Holloway, C.C.; sub-deacon, Rev. Father P. O'Brien, Inch St. Lawrence; minister of ceremonies, Rev. Father C. Fitzsimons, O.S.A.

AN APPRECIATION. A priest who knew him well and also ministers in Queensland, Australia, has written the following appreciation of Father Madden.

His early education he received at the Jesuit Fathers College, Limerick, and later at the Augustinian Fathers College, Dungarvan. When God called him to the Religious and priestly life, he entered the Augustinian Novitiate. Father Madden completed his studies for the priesthood in Dublin, and was ordained priest in that city on April 6th, 1916.
