CAUGHOO NAPPED

In Good Naas Field

The absence of Shagreen from to-morrow's £500 Newlands Chase at Naas makes **Caughoo** a really tempting-looking bet in this feature event (writes our racing correspondent, from Dublin, this evening.

The 1947 National winner jumped like a stage at Baldoye in the race won by Keep Faith, and although to-morrow's trip is a mile longer, Caughoo will relish the extra distance, for he was running on at the finish in Baldoye.

He will be ridden by D. McGann, who will also have the ride at Aintree. E. Dempsey, Caughoo's usual jockey, who rode the horse to its 1947 victory, is stated to have said that he doesn't feel fit enough to do the horse justice in the big event this year.

Main danger to Caughoo to-morrow may come from Coupe, which was recently gambled on, and Green Dolphin, which likes the course. I give Caughoo a confident vote, however.

Running Fire has been running prominently and is in nicely in the Osberstown Chase, where the Baldoyle winner, Gilt Edge, looks the chief danger.
