This will be followed by choral items, club drill, dance items, action songs, flag drill and, finally, a parade of 400 dancers, dressed in Gaelic costumes, will take place through Henry Street, Sarsfield Street and O'Connell Street. This will be wound up with a massed dance (Siege of Ennis) in O'Connell Street by the 400 at 4.30 p.m. An augmented ceilidhe band on the platform will provide appropriate music and loud speakers will be in operation here, too.

The Pageant will be brought to a close with a Ceilidhe Mor at Cruise's Hotel at 10 o'clock. All city cinemas are co-operating by putting on special St. Patrick's Day programmes, including Irish films, films of Irish interest and stage shows and interval music of famous Irish melodies.

All city hotels and restaurants are co-operating by opening for meals from 12 a.m. to 12 midnight.

The Committee promoting the Pageant request householders en route of each of the three parades to decorate their houses by displaying Papal, national and other flags.

Shopkeepers are asked to display only Irish made goods in their windows during St. Patrick's Week, and to mark sale price clearly on these articles.
