FERTILISER CREDITS (WHEAT) SCHEME.

Notice to holders of fertiliser credit dockets issued in respect of the 1945 wheat crop.

Arrangements have now been made to issue credit vouchers in exchange for fertiliser (credit) dockets issued for the 1945 crop.

The value of the vouchers, which may be used next season towards defraying the cost of artificial fertilisers, will be computed on the basis of 2s. 6d. for each barrel of wheat of the 1945 crop sold to authorised purchasers.

Wheat growers who hold fertiliser dockets should:

- (a) Obtain an application form (F.C.I.) from the nearest Post Office.
- (b) Complete the form according to the instruction printed thereon.
- (c) Transmit the completed form to which the dockets must be securely attached, to

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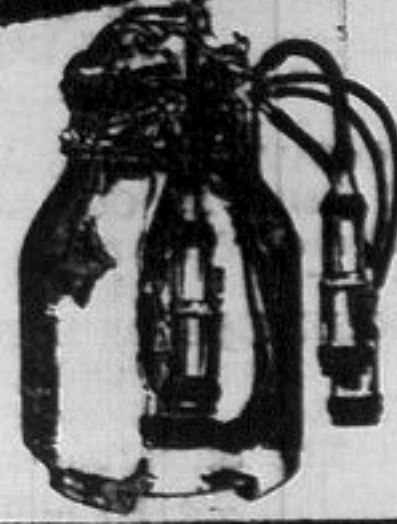
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
