ADARE MAN'S DEATH IN U.S.A.

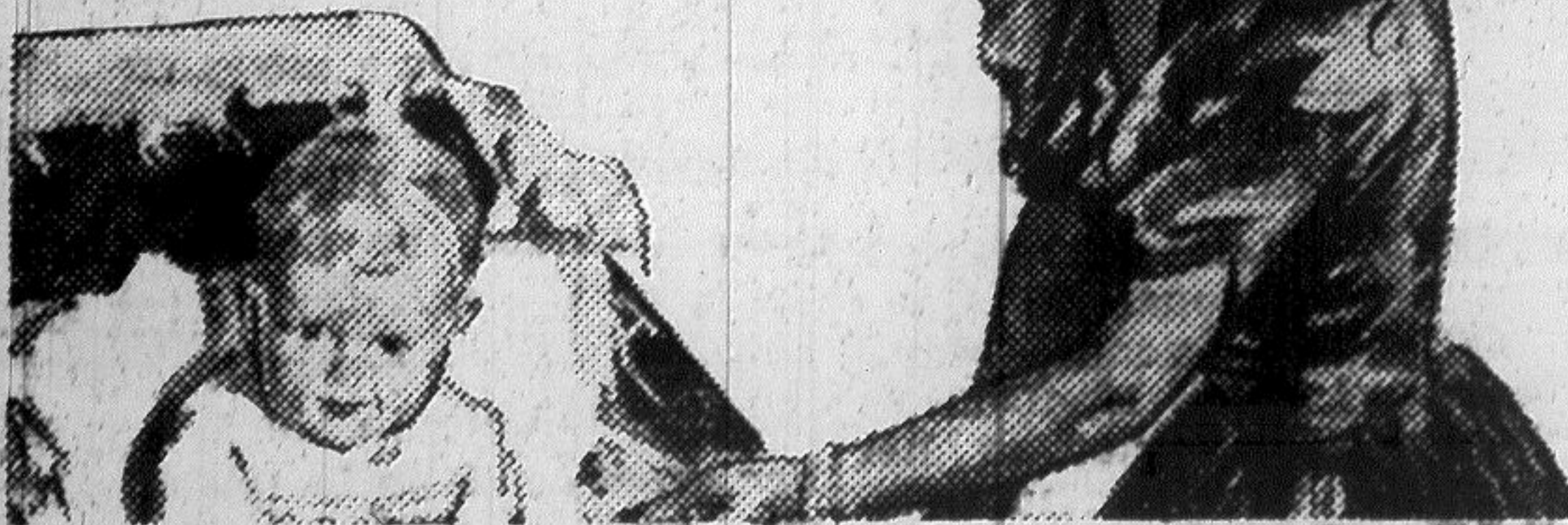
