WEATHER REVIEW

NOVEMBER, 1949

The following are the observa-
tions taken at the Crescent:—

Atmospheric Pressure. — High-
est barometer, 30.35, on the 1st;
lowest, 29.24, on the 21st; unsteady
throughout the month.

Temperature. — Highest ther-
mometer, 57 degrees F., on 3rd;
lowest thermometer, or coldest
nights, 34 degrees F., on 19th, 28th
and 29th.

Rainfall—Total rain fall, 4.64
inches, as against 2.15 last year.
Number of wet days or nights, 24,
as against 21 in 1948.

Remarks. — November was a
very unsettled month, with gale
winds around the 11th and 12th.
Frost was only recorded on the
nights of the 18th and 19th. The
rainfall in 1947 was 5.33 inches;
1946, 4.80; 1945, 1.67; 1944, 7.35;
1943, 4.17; 1942, 0.96; 1941, 6.56;
1940, 3.67.
