CHAMOIS LEATHERS.

A badly soiled chamois leather
should be soaked in a pint of soapy
water containing three table-spoon-
ful of ammonia. Work the leather
about in this, then rinse in tepid
water, rub well, and rinse in three
fresh waters.

ACCUMULATOR ACID.

There are still many homes where
a battery-operated wireless set is
used. If you spill acid from an
accumulator on a carpet or your
clothes, apply ammonia at once.
This will prevent the acid burning
a hole.

CARE FOR SKIN SHOES.

Skin shoes should be cleaned this
way:—Make sure that all dust and
dirt are removed from the shoes,
and then sprinkle a few drops of
peroxide on to a small sponge, and
lightly rub all over the skin. Place
to dry—preferably in the open air—
for about 45 minutes, and then
polish with a soft duster.
