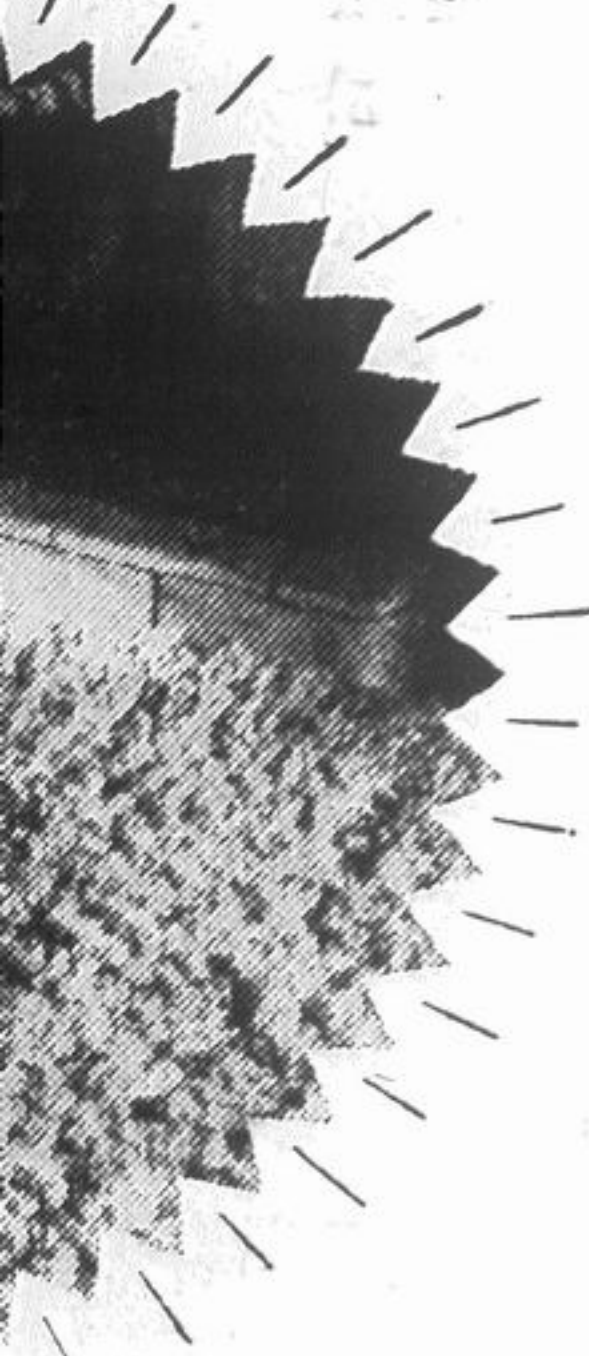

## FELL FROM TRACTOR

### GLIN FARMER'S DEATH

At Kinnaird, Glin, on Saturday evening, Mr. John Flynn, farmer, Drumrisk, Glin, fell from a tractor owned and being driven by Mr. Edward Flaherty, Tullyleague, and died as a result.

An inquest was held by Mr. Michael Cussen, solr., Rathkeale, Coroner, and a post mortem was made by Dr. Collins, Glin.

A jury of which Mr. Patrick D. Conway was foreman returned a verdict that death was the result of shock and heart failure, due to accidentally falling from the tractor.

The funeral of Mr. Flynn took place from Glin Parish Church to Kilfergus on Monday. Rev. Father Ryan, P.P., and Rev. Father Connors, C.C., Glin, officiated at the graveside.

Guard Maurice Flynn (brother) and Mrs. Flynn (widow) were the chief mourners.
