Mr. Dunworth said there was scarcely any necessity for him to introduce the Organiser, Mr. Walsh, who was present. He would place before the meeting the progress that the Farmers' Union was making in the county.

These were as follows: completed about three or four thousand; it now comprised over 30,000. No doubt it was late in the day for the farmers to organize, but better late than never.
