Denmark, Norway, and Sweden have extended the free recognition to Methuen and Lettland. A new small infantry field gun has been invented by Colonel Gaszerrier and successfully tested at Naples. The American Military Attaché representing the United States Ordnance Department, has presented. It is hoped that by July next Parisians will see the local steamboat service—the popular "batanz mouches"—restored on the Seine. The Department of the Seine will buy the whole equipment of the company, comprising 61 vessels. An official analysis of the unemployment figures for the London area shows that the total on 10th January 1921 was 158,764, compared with 151,320 the previous year, these figures excluding short-time workers. In spite of extensive dumping of German goods in Denmark as the result of the low value of the mark, the Danish Government has decided to prohibit imports or take measures likely to induce a fall in prices, but has undertaken not to elevate the position by raising railway rates, etc.

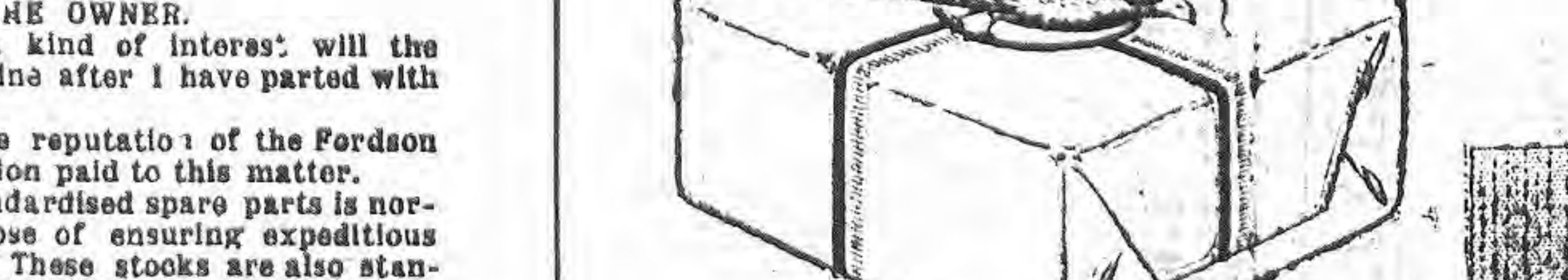
