

THE BLOCKADE IN KERRY.

A week ago it was announced that a large area West Kerry between Tralee and Dingle had been surrounded by troops, and that all communication between it and outside districts had been severed. Since then nothing has transpired as to what is occurring within the cordons, and it is generally believed that the military are carrying out a search for persons who are wanted, and are believed to be hiding in the district.

MR ASQUITH ON PREMIER.

Mr Asquith, re-opening the National Liberal Club last night, said the Premier, at the Constitutional Club, held up to oblige those who denounced reprisals in Ireland, and declared that the honour of Liberalism would not have been put at risk with that faction. He thought it would be a good idea to have the honour of Liberalism had to be vindicated on a Tory platform against the vast majority of Liberals.

CANADIAN CATTLE EMBARGO DEFENDED.

The Minister of Agriculture, defending the embargo on the admission of Canadian cattle, says there is no doubt if the ports were open to stores from overseas farmers would lose confidence in the prospect of making money by rearing calves, and thousands now saved would go to the butcher. Supplies of home-grown beef would thus be endangered, and what was more serious, the milk supply of the year to come would be seriously reduced.
