III—TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIPS. IV.—OTHER QUALIFICATIONS. Children of labourers or farmers whose valuation does not exceed £20 shall be entitled to a Scholarship. Children of farmers whose valuation exceeds £20 but does not exceed £50 may, at the discretion of the Committee, receive a reduced Scholarship, the value of which shall be determined by the Committee with a view to the parents' circumstances.
