THE IRISH PEACE MOVE.

General Smuts Received by the King.

A Press Association telegram says—The King to-day received General Smuts and the Minister for War in audience.

WHAT YOU CAN GET FROM COAL.

Here you ever thought what a lot of things you can secure from coal if you only take care to collect everything that is produced?

Let me tell you of a few substances that I get from my black lumps, writes a Star correspondent. In burning coal soot deposits, and it pays to gather as much of this as possible.

Soot is one of the most valuable fertilisers for all kinds of garden crops, it being very rich in plant foods. Then it is a splendid insecticide for destroying the numerous enemies of crops.

There is nothing quite like soot for keeping slugs and other pests from those tender seedlings that are so liable to attack.

"CROCUS" FOR CLEANING STEEL.

Hunt amongst the cinders for the substance known in trade circles as "crocus." This is a strange fluffy matter that adheres to the partially burnt coal, and it is usually of a bright orange colour.

Now crocus is the finest thing in all the world for cleaning steel and metal articles. There is nothing like it for getting up a fine polish with almost magical rapidity.

TO USE FEATHER LITTERS.

Most box-rooms contain a little hoard of old feathers of somewhat impossible colour, and not in the best of condition.

These may be turned to admirable account, says an ingenious correspondent, if used to cover a tight-fitting little tounge, which has previously been covered with silk of a bright tone, such as royal blue or old rose.

A soft layer of such feathers themselves, which seem to receive into a sort of embroidery effect underneath. Even the veriest amateur can turn out a smart tounge in this fashion.

HOW TO EKE OUT COAL.

Few people know how to use up their coal. Many, indeed, never use it up at all. Mix one-part of slack with an equal part of earth and well moisten with water.

Put mixture into old tin cans, and push down tightly. When the fire is well down put on some of the mixture, and press well down in a kitchen range; if an open grate place mixture at back and press down well. The fire will then last three hours without replenishing, give off a good heat and will burn quite red.
