LIMERICK COUNTY COUNCIL Scheme for Scholarships

Scheme for Scholarships From Primary to Secondary Schools in County Limerick. I.—NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS. Six of the annual value of £40. The Committee shall be at liberty to reduce the value of the Scholarship where the pupil's parents or guardians are in a position to bear part of the expense of his or her education.

II.—CONDITIONS OF TENURE. (A) The Primary School from which the pupil comes must have adopted the Gaelic League Education Programme as modified by Dall Eireann, etc. (B) The Secondary School which the pupil or his parents or guardians, choose for the holding of a Scholarship shall have adopted the Gaelic League Education Programme in Secondary Schools, viz. Irish to be taught to all pupils for vernacular use.

III.—TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIPS. The tenure of these Scholarships shall be four years provided the pupil shows satisfactory progress as tested by (a) the periodical school examination, (b) the annual school examination at the end of the academic year, (c) the special tests in Irish and Irish History applied by the Committee's Examiner at the end of each year.

IV.—RESIDENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS. Scholarships shall be restricted to pupils who are of Irish birth and whose parents or guardians have been resident in the County for three years.

V.—OTHER QUALIFICATIONS. Children of labourers or farmers whose valuation does not exceed £20 shall be entitled to a full Scholarship. Children of farmers whose valuation exceeds £20 but does not exceed £50 may, at the discretion of the Committee, receive a reduced Scholarship.
