The Economic Boycott. THE economic boycott of Belfast and the "north-east corner" goes on with undiminished determination and unabated vigour.

A member of the Daily Freeman has said an "Irish Independent" representative that Belfast merchants, in anticipation of the normal order from rest of the island, have been huge stocks on hand, and cannot now get rid of them, even at a considerable loss.

Financial ruin, it appears, threatens some of the biggest commercial firms in the island. In the linen business, it is added, the United States, which normally exports 100,000,000 of the Belfast manufactures, has ceased to trade, and Belfast travellers have been restricted from that country for the past three months without having a word of order.

The Daily Messenger says: "Yarn which was marked for sale at 80/- last year cannot now be sold at 60/-." All the big manufacturers have practically closed down "because of loss."

"When the Belfast and other north-eastern Ulster big textile mills, with their workers imposing any religious or political restrictions on them; when they have made fair competition to those who lost homes, furniture, and business through the insane orgies of the Orange men, and when north-eastern Ulster realizes that it is an integral part of Ireland and that its destiny must be the same as the rest of Ireland, then the rest of Ireland will resume trade relations with north-east Ulster, but not till then."

"This statement, we think, fairly represents the mind and attitude of the South and West of Ireland regarding the present boycott and it is to be hoped the north-eastern determination of which it is the expression will speedily convince the Northern bigwigs of the error and shortsightedness of their ways."
