MURKIN ALLEGED AFTER TWO YEARS

Case At Bradford Petty Sessions

On Monday last, for the first time since April, 1920, a petty sessions court was held at Bradford Co. Clare, but the only case before the court was at the suit of the Crown.

Major Johnston, V.O.M., was the only magistrate in attendance.

Two men, named Patrick and James Bentley, were charged on remand on the issue of a writ, the property of Michael Erawley, Monglaun, Co. Clare, about two years ago.

The sergeant stated that from information received he went to the farm of Michael Erawley, where he found a plough there; he then charged Moloney with unlawful possession of the plough.

Witness was about to repeat what Moloney said on the occasion, when Mr. J. H. Moran, solicitor, who appeared for the accused, objected on the ground that it was not evidence when the other accused were not present.

After a considerable discussion Major Johnston said he did not think it was evidence against the other two—the Bentleys.

The sergeant then proposed to examine Moloney as to the facts of the statements when Mr. Moran objected, and said it would be against all recognized rules of evidence to have such a thing allowed, inasmuch as Moloney was charged in connection with the same offence, and anything he said might be taken in evidence against him.

The objection was upheld, and the court refused information against Patrick and James Bentley.

Moloney was returned for trial to the next Quarter Sessions, nominal bail being allowed against him.
