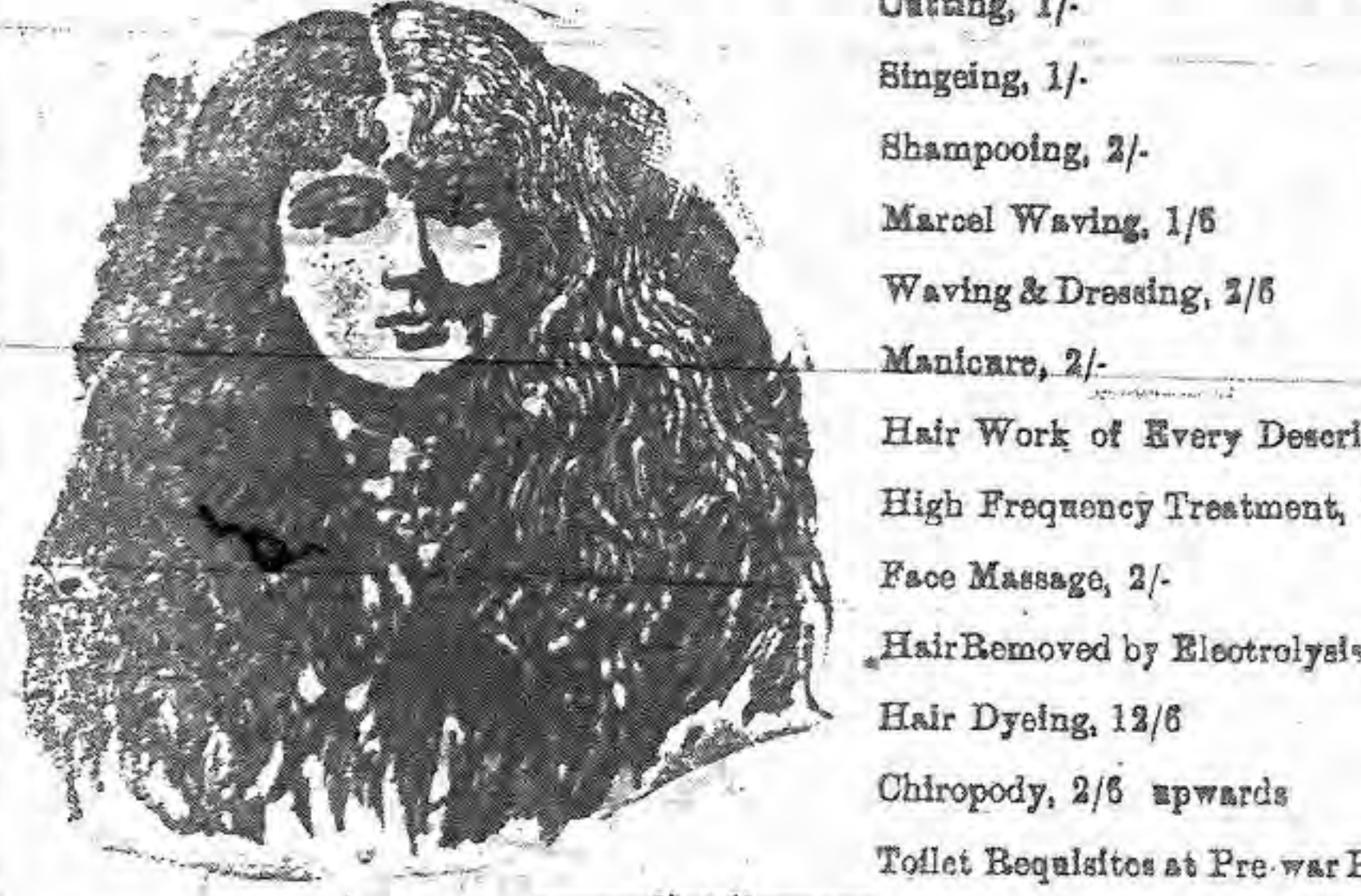

It is now stated that Sir John Lubbock has instructed Sir H. Greenwood to accept the arrangements for fixing the appointed day for the two Irish Parliaments. Lord French and Sir H. Greenwood are among those indicated for the Viceroyalty.

RAIDS AND ARRESTS In East Limerick Districts

During the past week large parties of military and police forces, including the Royal Irish Constabulary and the British Army, have been engaged in raids and arrests in the East Limerick districts. The operations were aimed at suppressing the activities of the Irish Republican Army.

LISTOWEL BLAZE Carnegie Hall Burned Down

The Carnegie Hall, Listowel, built about five years ago, valued at several thousand pounds, was totally destroyed by fire on Sunday night or early on Monday morning. The fire broke out in the rear of the building and spread rapidly, burning for several hours before being extinguished.

Widow Found Shot Dead

An official message says—Bridget Walpole, the widow of a farmer, aged 57, was found shot dead in a field at Ballyvaughan, on Sunday. A trail of blood led to the body, which was lying on its back with a hole in the forehead. The circumstances are enveloped in mystery.

EAST LIMERICK MAIL RAIDED

While a postman was conveying mails between Galbally and Tipperary on Sunday, 57th inst., he was held up by two armed and masked men near Kiltineo. He was relieved of all postal letters, and a parcel containing police warrants was also taken possession of by the raiders.

Death of Listowel Centenarian

Ellen Shanahan, a patient in the Listowel Union Infirmary, died at the age of 114 years. The deceased, who was blind from childhood from the effects of smallpox, was a familiar figure in the town a generation ago. She was only a few months past her 100th birthday when she was admitted to the infirmary.
