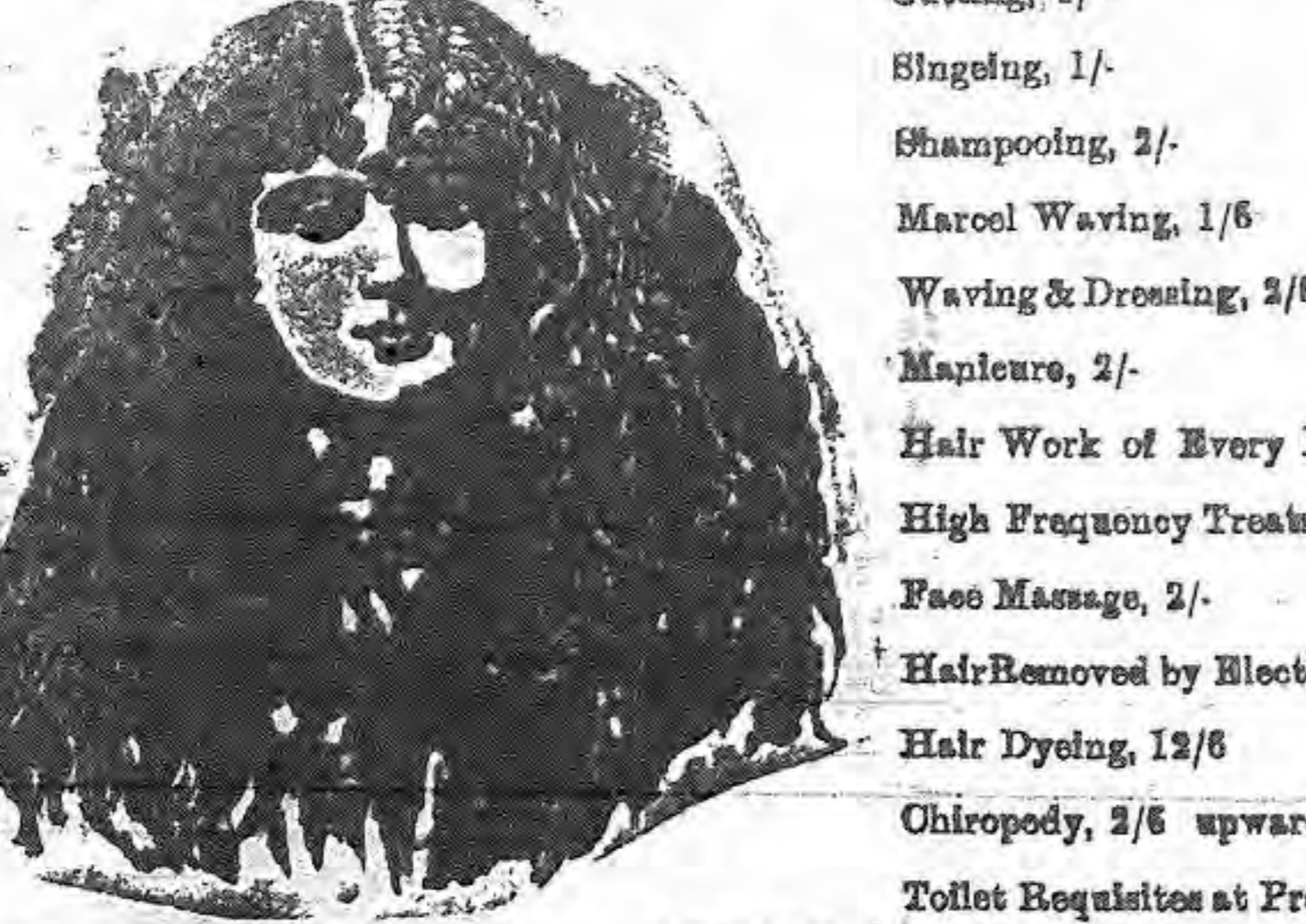

Maynooth Mission to China.

THE Maynooth Mission to China is a Society of priests and students which, with the approbation and encouragement of the Holy See and of our Bishops, has devoted itself to the conversion of China.
We have established in Ireland two Colleges for the education of students who have given their lives to this work.
Last year our first band of 16 priests arrived in China, where they have begun the work committed to us by the Holy See of converting FIVE MILLIONS OF PAGANS. They have only a few houses for their own accommodation; they have only nine poor chapels and an extremely small number of schools. They have appealed to us now very urgently for extensive and generous financial aid to enable them to provide a number of houses for themselves, chapels for their people, and schools for the hundreds of thousands of children who are clamouring for Christian education.

We temporarily saved 400,000 tons of peat, and this was a very great saving. The greater portion of this sum represents wages.
