



There will be large savings in the suspension of work under the Labourers Lots, Public Health Acts, new roads, work in quarter, and the reduction of expenses of the maintenance of roads which has been brought to a minimum commensurate only to the safety of the public. In these items alone over \$100,000 would be saved. So it was easy to see that not alone would future rates be because to the pre war level, but that the rates would be lewer. 

FIRM'S ACTION ECHO OF LUNERICK BURNIN

Against British Insurance Co In the King's Bench Division, Dublin, on Wednesday, bafors Mr Justice Pim, in the matter of an intended action of S B Waish and Son, merchants, Kilmallock v The British Commonwealth Insurance Co. Ltd. of London.

Mr James Comyn (Instructed by Mr Roger Fex. solicitor), on behalf of the plaintiff applied for an order giving liberty to issue and serve a writ out of jariediction upon the defendant company, a British company, having their registered offices at 19, Royal Exchange, London. . The plaintiffs' olaim was for £84 19s 7d, the amount of loss and damage due to them by the defendants on foot of a policy of lasurance. In an affidavit, Mr John J Walsh stated that he was the proprietor of the firm of & B Walsh and Son. On November 8th, 1920, the defendant company, through their agents, Mesers Frank Gibson, Lloyd and Co, Lid, of 30,

Anglesea street, Dablin, lessed a policy of tosucance to his firm, whorsby, in consideration of a payment of a premlum of £427 10s, the defendants agreed to idemp fy his firm against any loss or damage to the property of the firm directly caused by rioters, civil commotions, war, sivil war, revolutions, rebellions, military, police or usurped power, during the period of six calendar months commencing on November 5th, 1920, and anding May 4th, 1921. He paid the premium of \$497 10: on foot of the policy, and on December 20th, 1920, less and damage to the amount of \$84 10s 7d was caused to the property of his firm by the military and police or usurped power. He duly acquainted the defendants, and requested payment, but the defendants had refused to pay him his just

Mr Justice Pim granted the application.


