THE EMBARGO QUESTION Operations of American Meat 'Trust' The operations of the American Meat 'Trust' were discussed on Monday's sitting of the Royal Commission on the Importation of Meat, during the cross-examination of Mr B. Gaid, of the Royal Statistical and Economic Society, by the Hon. Sir Charles H. G. O'Connell, representing the interests favoring the removal of the embargo on Canadian cattle. Witnesses said that he did not agree, and he added that his suggestion was that the Canadian cattle would be 'dumped' here. Crossed by counsel on the suggestion of 'dumping' by Canada, and ordinary economic trading by Ireland, witness replied that figures proved that Ireland's supply varied in accordance with demand, whereas Canada's supply would be erratic; it would be surplus stock governed by economic factors quite outside the United Kingdom. Mr Charteris—You have, in effect, a duty against Canadian cattle in this country of £14, and in spite of that it would pay to 'dump' cattle? I do not say it would pay. Then what is the object? The object is to give the 'Trust' a much more efficient reason than they ever had for getting this country entirely under their control. There would be a loss of confidence among the breeders, and the ulterior motive of the Meat 'Trust' to monopolize the supply of cattle in order to get control. Lord Ashwith—Do you think that the 'Trust' would be in the 'Trust', and assist in this 'dumping'? I could not tell. Is your knowledge of 'Trusts' anything more than a sort of fear of a ghost? Not necessarily. I have studied the operations of 'Trusts.' Mr Charteris—Can you, then, say why the 'Trusts' should not operate with the stores coming from a part of the United Kingdom, as well as with stores coming from a part of the Empire? The witness did not answer, and Mr Charteris added: 'Very well, we will leave this matter.' Mr W. P. Neil, Chairman of the Cattle Market Committee of the City Corporation, London, gave evidence in support of the removal of the embargo, and stated that the risks of supplies to this country suddenly cut off by international complications was an argument in favour of making every possible means of increasing the supply of cattle in this country without delay. He did not consider that there was any danger in the removal of the embargo, and would have been glad to see the embargo removed. The witness said that he had long objected to women smoking in public. 'But she had just seen some when walking in Washington he saw a young woman outside a picture theatre receive a cigarette from her suitor's mouth and then several puffs.
