





IRISH PRODUCE

Wholesale Prices

The following is the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland's return of the average wholesale prices of egel cultural produce at certain Irish markets during the week suded 15th Gesober, 1931, as compared with the previous week.. The prices shows are the average wholesale prices paid in the markets mentioned for the partisuing quality of produce sold thers. In some sentres the better qualities of produce are purshared by merchants direct from producers without passing through the regular market.

Begg-Hen aggs advanced still further in price from the week pravious. The advance was not so marked in the Northern countles Priess in Belfast rose from 80s per 120 to 31e 8d and at Londonderry from 22s 5tl to 27s 6d. I Dublin the previous week's price of 25s 53 hardened to 30s, and at Euniscorthy, Cork and Limerick rates advanced from 22s 61, 30s 10d and 23s ld to 25s, 23s lld and 27s 6d, respec bively. Duck eggs also showed an upward trend in values. At Belfast and Londonderry prices ross from 80s 5d to 22s 51 per 120 to 32s 11d and 27s 6d, respectively. In Kontscorth; the advance was from 21s 6d to 25s, at Oora from 20: 10d to 32s 11d, and at Limerick from 34s 2d to 30s.

Farmer's Butter - Farmer's butter was cheaper at all markets, except at Honiscorthy, where the price advanced from 1s to 1s 2d per 1b. Prices dropped Id per lb at Belfast; Loudenderry and Dublin to is 9d, Es 7d and in 3d respectively. There was also a fall at Cork from 11gd so 11d, and at Limerick from 1s 10d

Poultry - Prices for poultry varied little from the previous week. Chickens in Dablin and Beliest repeated the existing currency of 11: 6: and its per pair. At Enniscorthy and Lamerick prices were unchanged as 7s and 6s per pair respectively. At Oork prices improved hom 4s to 5s 4d per pair. Prices for hens were much on the same level, though apward tendency was noticeable nome markets. At Helfast prices rose from 7e 6d to 6s 6d per pair, but gave way at Londonderry from 6: 84 to 5; 2d. Dublin prices dropped from 9: 6d to 7s 6d and Enniscorthy prises from Se to 6s 6d. At Cork there was slight wearening in value from 3s 6d to 8s 4d per pair. Prices ross at Limerick from 5: 6: to 6s per pair. Ducks were dearer at 9s by 61 per pair in Beifast, and cheaper in London derry at 5: by the same amount. The level of 7s per pair was unchanged in Dablin. Cork prices dropped from 3: 5d to 3: 1d per pair, and at Limerick the previous week's rate of 5s

Potatoes-Except at Cork, where prices remained unchanged at 5: 4d per cws, posseces all round sold as a lower level. The fall at Betfast and Londonderry was from 3: 10d and 3: 61 per swe to 3s 8d and 3s per owe, respectively. The rate in Dablis fell from 6s 8d to 5e 81; at Espisecriby from 60 to 40 8d, and at Limerick from 4s 10s to 4s 8d per sws. The average price per swi for Up-to-Date variaties during the week was - Belfast Sa Sd, Newry 2s, Ballymoney is id, and Limerick 4s. These rates are upchanged from the previous week except at Ballymoney, where prices were easier by 33 per ewt. The corresponding rates for the week as Cork and Ballina were be 3d and 3s 1d per swi, respectively.




