The future of the dairying industry in the County Limerick was very fully discussed. It was pointed out that lightning strikes were absolutely detrimental to successful dairy farming.

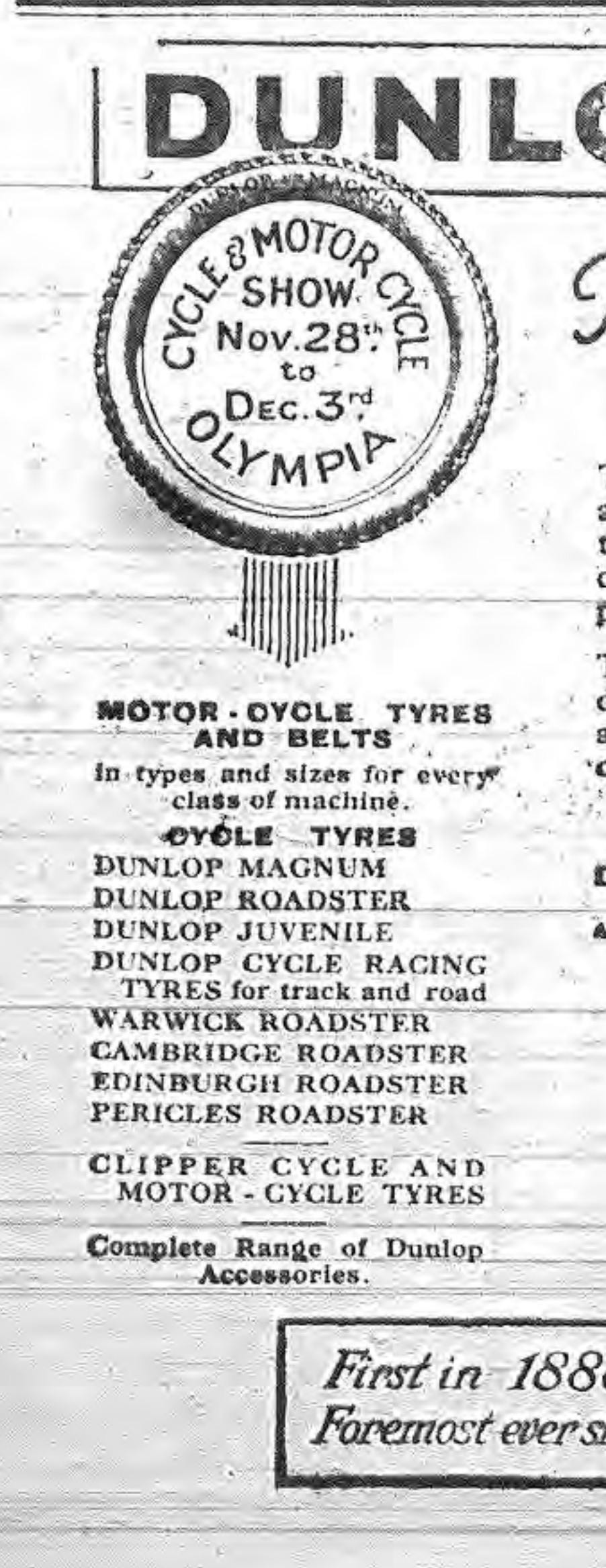
As the monthly meeting of the Glin School Board on Monday, Mr. Thomas Markham, Chairman of Keshmole Board of Guardians, in the chair.
