

trime to wantonly leave oows annilked. As the matter now stood, it was pointed out, the dairying industry in County Limerick will be abandoned, and a large number of workers will be disamployed. The dairying system is a very seader one and requires special care to be in any way successful. The contract system of laboar in County Limarick has on the whole worked well, except where the contracts have been broken, and due attention has not been paid to the thorough milking of the cows. In the former production has been stopped in the creameries, and in the latter the richest portion of the milk to left in the cow's udder. The individual farmers suffer loss, but the nation sussains loss in the same proportion, A great deal has been said about starting new industries in Ireland to give employment to our ever insreasing population, but the big industry we have, vis : agriculture, in its various phases, should be brought as near perfection as possible and not hampered by "lightning strikes" which impeds its development. The farmer should be master in his own house and director of his own business; otherwise the industry in which he is engaged will perish. 
