TENURE

The premises are described in the Grant as "All that and those the said plot of ground and houses commonly called 'The Great Horn Works,' situate, lying and being outside of Mungret Gate, formerly in the South Liberties of the City of Limerick, but now, under and by virtue of the Municipal Boundary Act, situate within the Borough of said City of Limerick, and which said premises are bounded on the East with the road leading from the City of Limerick to Adare, on the North with part of the late Dowdall Hammond's holdings and part of Dr. Jones's holdings, and on the West with a small plot of waste ground and part of said Hammond's holdings, in as full, large and ample and beneficial a manner as Isaac Jacques, deceased, formerly held and enjoyed the same, containing in length on the South side thereof 130 feet, and on the North side thereof 140 feet, be the same more or less, together with the tithes thereof."

The Grantee covenants to keep in repair the premises and all improvements, tenantable accidents always excepted.
